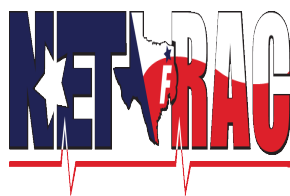

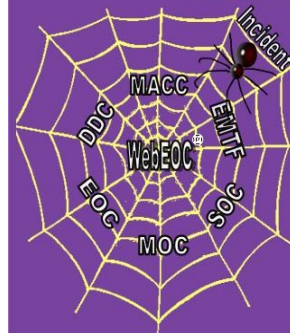

Dr. Paul McGaha, D.O., M.P.H., is currently the Regional Director for Health Service Region 4 and 5 (North) of the Texas Department of State Health Services. This encompasses a 35-county area in East Texas. He received his medical degree from the College of Osteopathic Medicine at Oklahoma State University. He is certified by the American Board of Preventive Medicine in Public Health and General Preventive Medicine. In addition, he holds a Master of Public Health Degree from the University of Texas Health Science Center in Houston.

The Southwest Texas Regional Advisory Council (STRAC) is one of 22 regional councils in Texas that comprise the Texas Trauma/Emergency Healthcare system. STRAC's membership currently includes 53 hospitals and 71 EMS agencies. The State of Texas' Department of State Health Services and STRAC recognized that WebEOC® would be a crucial component to successful management of problems on a regional and state level. To that end they created the Texas WebEOC® Interoperability Project (TWIRP) whose task was to ensure that WebEOC® was integrated statewide to the fullest extent possible. TWIRP CISE will be some of the lead instructors at the workshop, including Jeff Newbold, Kris Ramsey, Barrett Hanks and Frankie Trifilio.
