- ♦ <u>Status of Various Funding Sources</u> (EMS County, EMS RAC, Sys&Dev, and Senate Bill 8)
 - Carmen Stuck gave an update on all expenditures made in each of the funding streams. None of the FY24 EMS County money has been
 spent at this time. Some expenses have been paid from EMS RAC and Systems & Development such as travel and office utilities. There
 has been some money used in the Systems & Development account for TNCC and other program expenses. There has been very little
 spent in the Exceptional Item account.
- ♦ SB8 Additional \$150,000 Award
 - Carmen Stuck announced that DETRAC has received an additional \$150,000 in Senate Bill 8 funds to distribute for EMS scholarships
 and encouraged members to put the word out.
- ♦ Needs Assessment / Grant Review Process
 - Needs requests are now being accepted till February 29th. The Needs Grant Review Meeting will be held in Lufkin this year and will take place in March. A date for the review meeting will be sent out soon.
